# Training Process

Day 1 - April 3rd 2013

1. Opening by Dian to welcome all participants.

**Notes:** Agenda 1 – 5 was done in the statistic division building because the Bappeda hall was used by Bupati who were having the data handover of future elector for local general election in Gunung Mas District 2013. The Bupati event is actually a sudden event that was informed to Bappeda on Tuesday afternoon, which is one day before the event. The substitute room is very thigh and quite hot. The small room was used for about 60 minutes and then continued in the Bappeda hall after the Bupati event was finished. However, high appreciation should be given to Bappeda Gunung Mas as they have prepared well the substitutes venue completed with 30 chairs. It proved that they have sense of belonging to YTS governance event for the District governance.

Comments from participants during the presentation:

**Abrori, Education Agency** - *“There are SKPDs that are not covered in Bupati vision and mission, what about their strategic planning? What to do?”*

**Nandang** - *“as a head of the district, a Bupati has to breakdown the renstra for those SKPDs to make it still relevant with the Bupati vision and mission. It needs to be made more detailed. In this case, those SKPDs have to be more proactive and have more communication with the Bupati in order to make relevant renstra.”*

Comments during the presentation when the participants seemed to be confused with the new materials on Renstra:

**Abrori – education agency:** *I realized that it is not easy to everyone here. Now we focus on the flow of this strategic plan. I have been in the planning section for about 4 years. The beginning must be confusing, however the more you do and practice it, the more expert you are in planning. I learned a lot by myself, and this training material is very useful, especially for those of us who are still new in the planning section in our agencies.*

**Nandang:** *Germany actually the same in terms of autonomy. In Germany and Italy the amount of APBD given to the central government is decided by local government. However, in Indonesia the amount of APBD given to the central government is decided by the central government itself.*

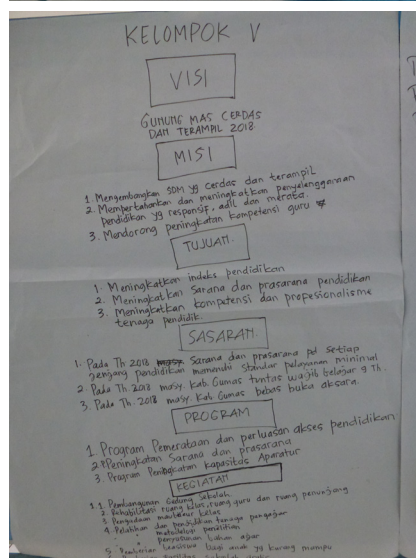
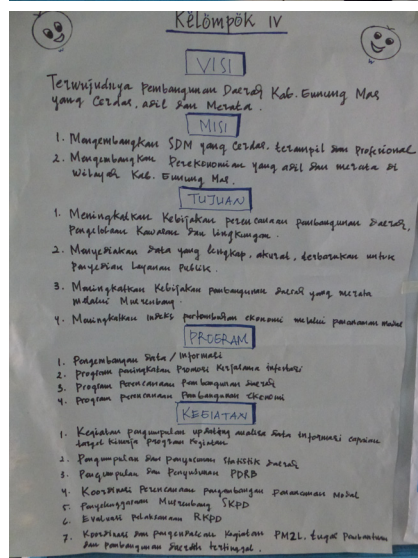
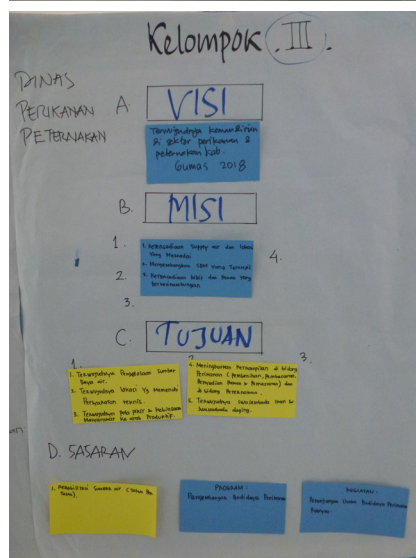
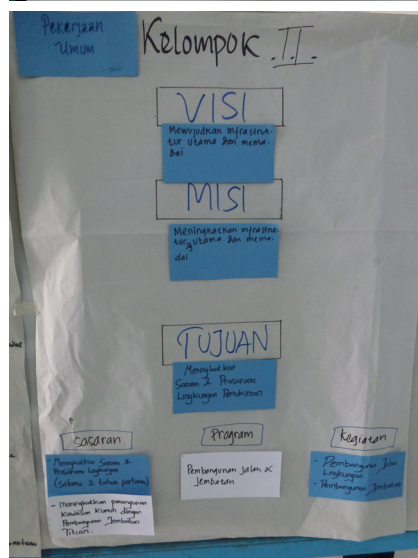
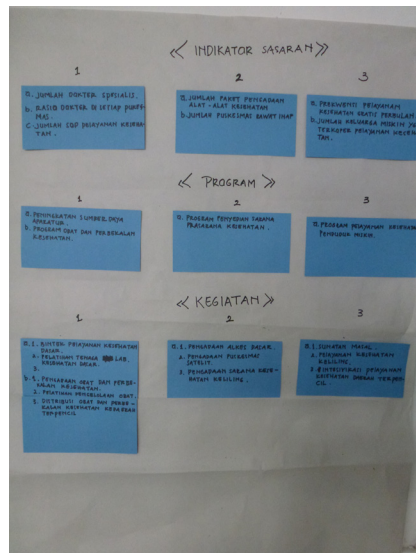
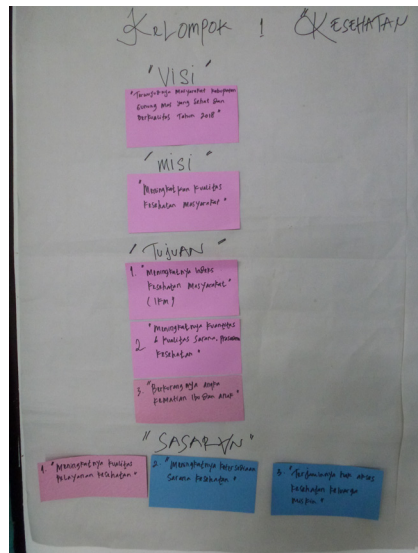
##### 5. Group work: Making target, program and activities.

11. Feedback from 2 new participants (Hera Merentina from Kec. Kurun and Harapan Sihar, SE from KPPT Kurun)



**Hera** - I have got the same kind of training in Batam. However, I get better comprehension with Pak Nandang as the trainer. My suggestion is the timing for the training should be added at least 3 days because I found it very useful.



**Harapan** - This is the first time I got training from YTS. I get benefits from the training. However, in my opinion, this training should be conducted at least 3 or 4 days so we can get much deeper comprehension with the materials.

**Jepin** - This is the second time YTS conducts this strategic plan training for us, if I am not mistaken. I hope this will bring benefits to everyone here. Fortunately, the Bupati event only took about 1 hour so then we could move in this more representative room until today. Renstra should be made by each Agency/SKD in line and relevant with the Bupati vision to Gunung Mas District. This is valid for 5 years ahead. For example we have our Renstra from 2009 – 2014, and for 2014 – 2019 we need to make this again. Therefore every planning section in each agency or SKPD should have personnel who are able to make this properly. We are lucky to have Mr. Nandang and YTS to help us.
